

Eligibility:

Graduating high school senior planning to attend fulltime in a post high school educational institution and a Western member in good standing in a Wisconsin and Upper Michigan lodge.

Award Amount:

Award amount and number of awards will vary. Minimum award amount of \$500, maximum award amount of \$1,000.

Selection:

Recipients are selected prior to high school graduation by the Community Foundation Scholarship Selection Committee. Selection may be based on academic achievement, extracurricular activities, community activities, financial assistance, and a written statement.

Payment Procedure:

Scholarship payments will be released after submission of the following to the Community Foundation: scholarship verification form, verification of full time student status for 2nd semester (class schedule with credits listed), and grade transcripts from the first semester of freshman year of college or technical school. After approval of submitted documentation, the scholarship check will be paid directly to the school the recipient will be attending during the second semester of the freshman year of college or technical school.

Loss of Eligibility:

Failure to register as a full-time student for both the first and second semesters of your freshman year of college or technical school will result in eligibility. In addition, you must provide your first semester grade transcript (unofficial is acceptable) to the Community Foundation no later than March 1st, of your second semester.
